

## It's Citrus Time!

To help support our local chapter and this year's Amigos participants, the Board and 2018 participant families are selling ruby grapefruit and navel oranges. Here are all of the details for the citrus sale that you need to know –

**Each 20-pound box of navel oranges or ruby grapefruit is \$25. We encourage every participant family to sell at least 15 boxes of citrus.**

If your friends and family do not like citrus but still want to support the Seattle Amigos chapter and participants, they may choose to have their box of citrus donated to a local food bank. This way their citrus purchase will support two great causes!

**Orders are due no later than Tuesday, November 28.** Please note all of your orders in the spreadsheet provided and email it to our Fundraising Coordinator, Lilia, at [fundraising@seattleamigos.org](mailto:fundraising@seattleamigos.org).

There are two ways to pay for citrus orders:

- Via check made out to *Amigos de las Americas, Seattle Chapter*. Checks can be mailed to P.O. Box 30129, Seattle, WA 98113-0129 or given to you when you make the sale/deliver the order. (You may either bring the checks to the December citrus pick up, January 7 training or mail them to the P.O. Box.)

**Orders will be ready for pick-up from Charlie's Produce in SoDo (4123 – 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave. S) on Sunday morning, December 10 between 8:30 and 9:30 am. You will be responsible for picking up all the boxes of citrus that you sell** and either 1. Delivering the citrus to your friends and family who purchased it, or 2. Making arrangements for your friends and family to pick it up from you.
